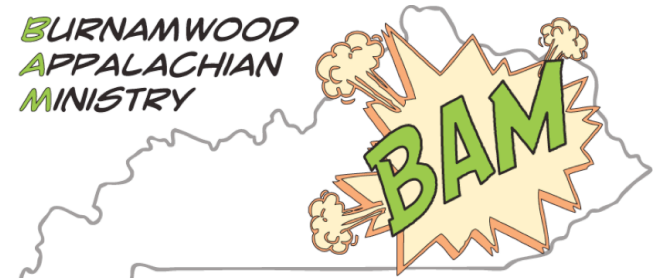

## ACCOMMODATIONS

### LODGING

Groups will stay in a three-story, air-conditioned, mountain home. The home includes room for 30 participants, 2 full bathrooms, 2 living rooms, a full kitchen, and a game room. Additional showers and bathrooms are within walking distance.

For groups larger than 30, additional lodging is available on site and will be coordinated with the BAM Director.

### FOOD

Meals are provided for all breakfasts, lunches, and dinners with the exception of the dinner on your free day.

### WORKSITES

All worksites will be coordinated and prepared for the specific abilities of your group. Groups will serve Irvine and its surrounding counties.

### LEADERSHIP

The BAM Director lives on-site and will be guiding your group and providing support for your participants during the week.

## GUIDELINES

All participants must have completed the 6th grade.

There must be 1 adult chaperone for every 5 youth.

A non-refundable deposit of \$50.00/estimated number of participants is due no later than two weeks after reservation.

Groups are responsible for providing their own transportation.

### COST

\$225/person

Camps run from Sunday evening to Friday morning and includes all accommodations, work-site materials, food, leadership, and a lifeguard.
