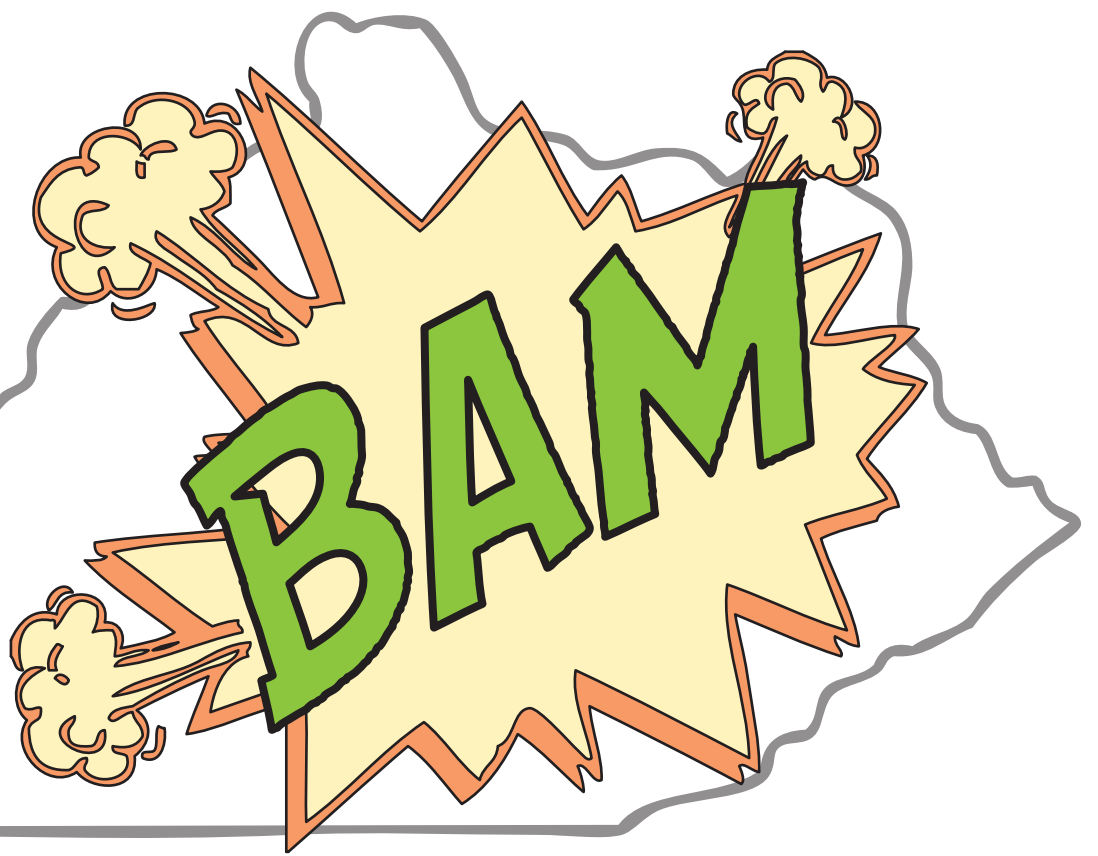


# BURNAMWOOD APPALACHIAN MINISTRY

**WORK SITES:** Provided!  
The work will vary depending on group size and age, but the jobs will be lined up ahead of time in Irvine and the surrounding communities.

**LEADERSHIP:** Provided!  
There will be an on-site work camp coordinator that will work with your group all week!

**COST:** \$225.00 per person.  
Camps run from Sunday evening (5:30pm) through Friday afternoon (1:00pm) in June and July. The cost includes your housing, food, on-site director, lifeguards, and work-site materials.

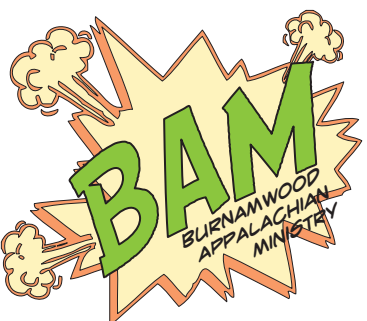
## Guidelines:

- All participants must have completed the 6th grade.
- There must be 1 adult chaperone for every 5 youth.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 per estimated number of campers is due no later than two weeks after verbal reservation.
- Groups must provide their own transportation to and from work sites.
