CAMPER AND PARENT INFORMATION

SUMMER CAMP ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES

During all summer camp sessions, arrival times on the first day of the camp session will be at 10 a.m. and departure time will occur on the last day of the camp session, at 11 a.m.

Exceptions are MADD Camp which holds a Finale for family and friends from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. with pick up of campers following the performance AND the 1st and 2nd Grade Mini Camp which will have a pick-up time of 5 p.m. on Saturday.

FIRST DAY OF CAMP CHECK IN PROCEDURE

Check-In Location:

Once arriving at the Main Pavilion, campers and parents must come to the Camp Office to notify the staff of their arrival. At that time Paper Work will be double checked to make sure your camper's registration and medical information have been received and are complete. Also all medication must be turned in to the staff, to ensure the health and safety of your child, as well as others campers.

COUNTDOWN TO ARRIVAL AT BURNAMWOOD

3 Months Out

- Check when your camper last had his/her health physical and make sure everything is up to date.
- Double check the dates of your camp session.
- Would it be helpful for your camper to see camp? Schedule a tour by emailing info@burnamwood.net.

2 Months – 1 Month Out

- Communicate any pertinent information about your camper to the Executive Director by e-mailing info@burnamwood.net
- Talk “realistically” about their expectations of the camp experience (especially if this is their first visit).
- Double check the “ What to Bring to Camp” list to ensure you have everything needed!

2 – 3 Days Before Arrival

- Pack everything that is needed!
- Gather and Label any medication that is currently being taken by the camper (on bottle or bag).

- Casual Camp Clothes
- Some “Dress for the Mess” Clothes
- Underwear and Socks
- Swim Suit
- Rain Poncho/Jacket
- Jacket or Sweatshirt
- 2 Pairs of Shoes (something closed-toed, at least one pair)
- Pillow
- Sleeping Bag OR Sheets and Blanket
- Towels
- Personal Toiletry Articles
- Insect Repellent
- Flashlight and Extra Batteries
- Prescription Medications Needed

SUMMER CAMP AND RETREAT COVENANT

Before you come to camp, please review the covenant, which covers expectations for camp conduct. It is important that all campers understand this covenant. Knowing that we are a community of faith, all participants at Summer Camp and Retreat Sessions are expected to observe the following guidelines during our time together

1. Act as a messenger of God’s love at all times.
2. Respect everyone – respect each other’s feelings, dignity, and personal property. Treat others in the way that you would like to be treated.
3. Listen, share, care.
4. Be on time – for activities, meetings and curfew.
5. Participate in all activities and maintain a positive attitude.
6. Help and serve everyone in every way possible.
7. Laugh a lot – yet get serious when necessary.
8. Respect the property of Burnamwood.
9. NO use of illegal drugs, alcohol, and/or tobacco is permitted.
10. NO weapons, firearms, or fireworks are allowed on Burnamwood property.
11. Campers are NOT permitted in any of the cabins or sleeping units of the opposite sex. No one is to leave the lodge or cabin area by him or herself.

All campers and parents are to understand that if a camper does not abide by these guidelines, they will be sent home at the expense of the camper’s parent/guardian or their local church.
