## **FIRST DAY OF CAMP CHECK IN PROCEDURE**

Check-In Location Once arriving at the Main Pavilion, staff and volunteers will greet you. Notify the nurse on your arrival of any medication that your camper may have. For the safety of all campers, medication is kept under the supervision of the nurse and is given at the appropriate times required. Once checked-in, your camper can place their luggage in the pavilion and get their nametag. Once check-in time is over, we move to cabins together.

- Swim Suit
- Rain Poncho/Jacket
- Jacket/Sweatshirt
- 2 Pairs of Shoes (at least one pair of something closed-toed, i.e. tennis shoes, boots, etc.)
- Pillow, Sleeping Bag or Sheets and a Blanket (twin beds)
- Personal Toiletry Articles
- Insect Repellent and Sunscreen
- Flashlight/Head Lamp and Extra Batteries
- Water Bottle
- Prescription Medications Needed

## **SUMMER CAMP AND RETREAT COVENANT**

Before you come to camp, please review the covenant, which covers expectations for camp conduct. It is important that all campers understand this covenant. Knowing that we are a community of faith, all participants at Summer Camp and Retreat Sessions are expected to observe the following guidelines for our life together:
